Glen has more than 20 years of experience in precious metals exploration, resource development and business development and brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to the board of Sarama. Most recently, Glen served as Senior Vice-President, Exploration for Kinross Gold Corporation (“**Kinross**”), where he managed global exploration activities and led teams on a number of important new, near-mine discoveries in Russia and Chile.

Glen also oversaw exploration at the Tasiast mine in Mauritania which resulted in a major resource expansion and additional discoveries. He commenced his career with WMC Resources and later joined Goldfields Exploration Ltd and Placer Dome Asia Pacific.

Glen graduated with a B.Sc.(Honours) from the University of Melbourne and earned his PhD from the University of Tasmania.
